



God's Word says what is true.

Psalm 119

Like the psalmist, we can trust in the Word (v. 42), knowing that it is altogether true (v. 142). We can't trust

everything we read on the Internet. We can't trust all the facts given by our politicians. We can't even trust the fact-checkers who check those facts! Statistics can be manipulated. Photographs can be faked. Magazine covers can be airbrushed. Our teachers, our friends, our science, our studies, even our eyes can deceive us. But the Word of God is entirely true and always true:

God's Word is firmly fixed in the heavens (v. 89); it doesn't change. There is no limit to its perfection (v. 96); it contains nothing corrupt. All God's righteous rules endure forever (v. 160); they never get old and never wear out.

If you ever think to yourself, "I need to know what is true— what is true about me, true about people, true about the world, true about the future, true about the past, true about the good life, and true about God," then come to God's Word. It teaches only what is true:

SCRIPTURE

Sanctify them through thy truth: thy word is truth. John 17:17

As you start to memorize a verse...

Read in your Bible the context of each verse you memorize.

Try to gain a clear understanding of what each verse actually means. Read the verse through several times thoughtfully, aloud or in a whisper. This will help you grasp the verse as a whole. Each time you read it, say the topic, reference, verse, and then the reference again.

Discuss the verse with God in prayer, and continue to seek His help for success in Scripture memory.
